Ordinary Motions

a) Budget 2013-2014

CB: Invites RH to propose the motion.

RH: Explains that all societies' budget requests were approved, with the exception of the Jewish Society's celebrations budget of £500, which was cut to £200. The Diogene Film Society is still in the process of finalising its budget request and is therefore not in the current draft of the budget, but is set to receive £125.

CB: Recommends that, in the absence of any queries or concerns, the motion is put to a vote.

b) CUSU Sexual Health Scheme Launch

CB: Invites LH to propose the motion.

LH: Explains that CUSU is changing its method of supply of sexual health welfare. Condoms are no longer going to be bought by colleges, but given to colleges for free as long as they meet the code of practice, to which Jesus College already largely conforms. CUSU-led training of the college welfare officers is a condition which will have to be met by next year's JCSU. No radical changes will be needed and the new system will free up some of the welfare budget.

CB: Recommends once more that, in the absence of any queries or concerns, the motion is put to a vote.
